

The Committee asks that you provide testimony about allegations in Senator George Mitchell's *Report to the Commissioner of Baseball of an Independent Investigation into the Illegal Use of Steroids and Other Performance Enhancing Substances by Players in Major League Baseball* that you and other Major League Baseball players used performance enhancing drugs during your professional baseball career.

The Committee also requests your appearance at a deposition or transcribed interview on this topic on Thursday, January 24, 2008, at 9:30 a.m., in Room 2157, Rayburn House Office Building.
